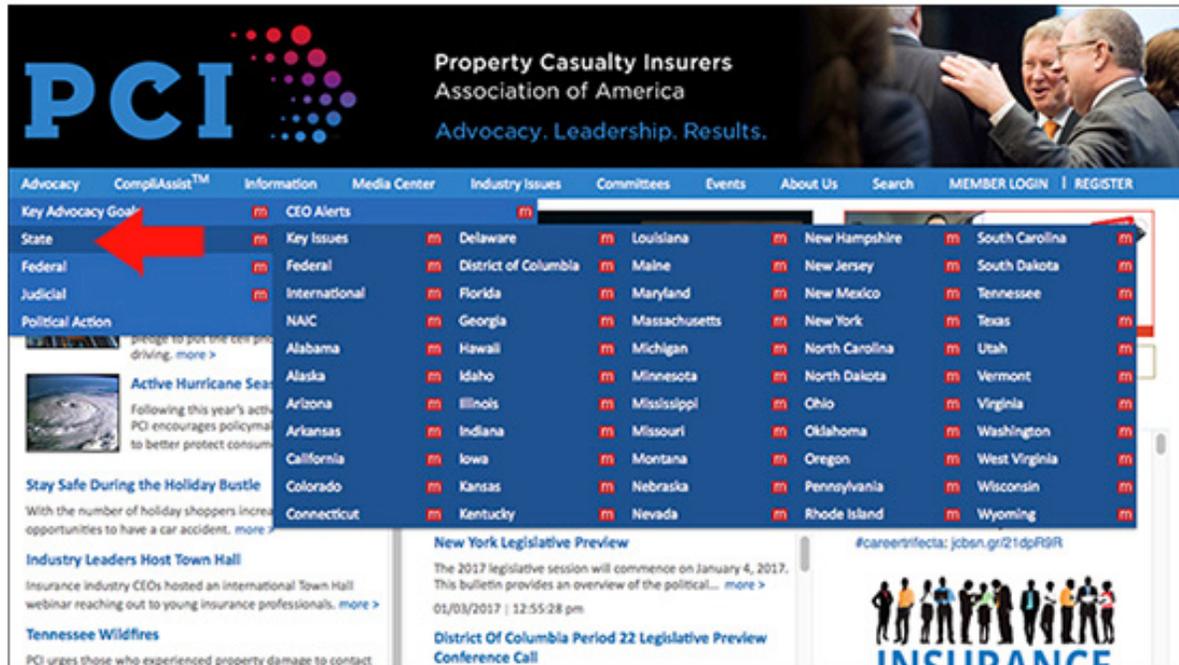

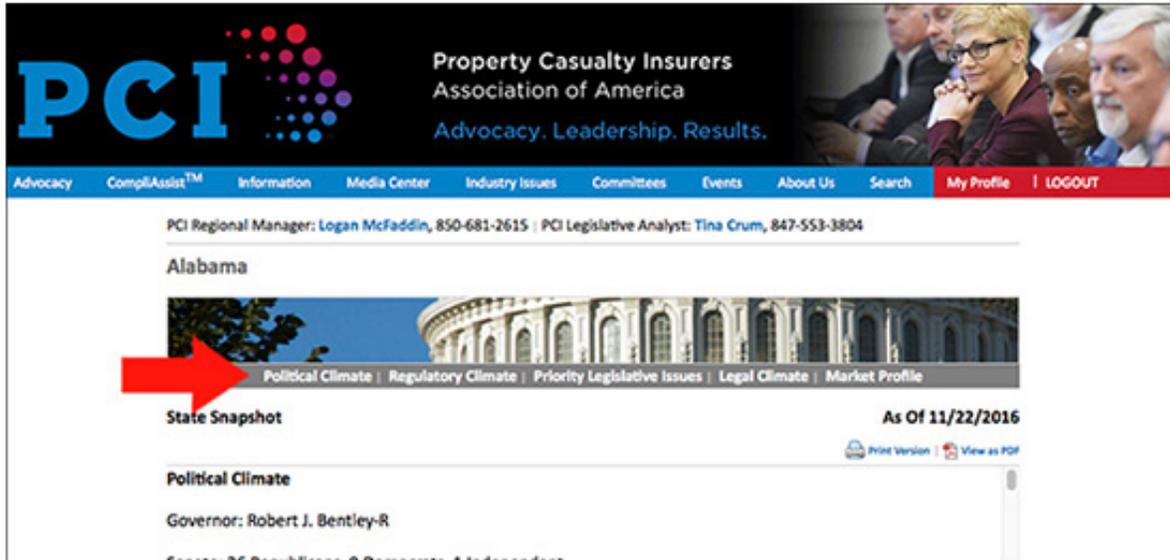
Getting there is simple:



Log on to the PCI website. Then, under the Advocacy tab on the left, click on State and choose the state you're interested in.

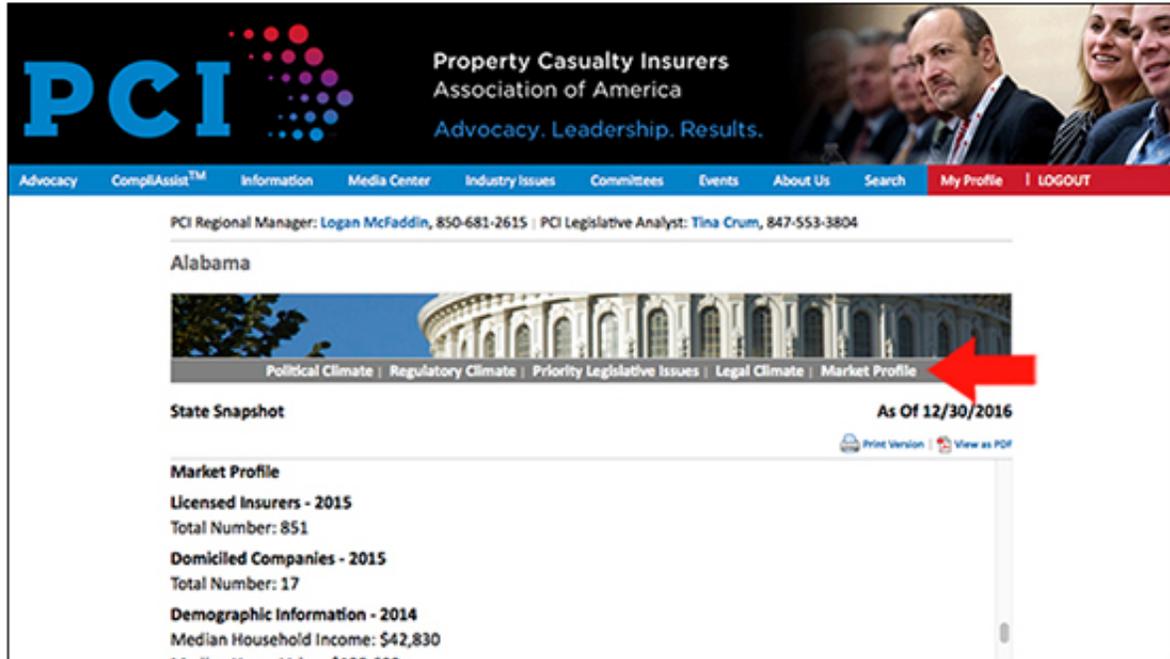

New Market Profile Section

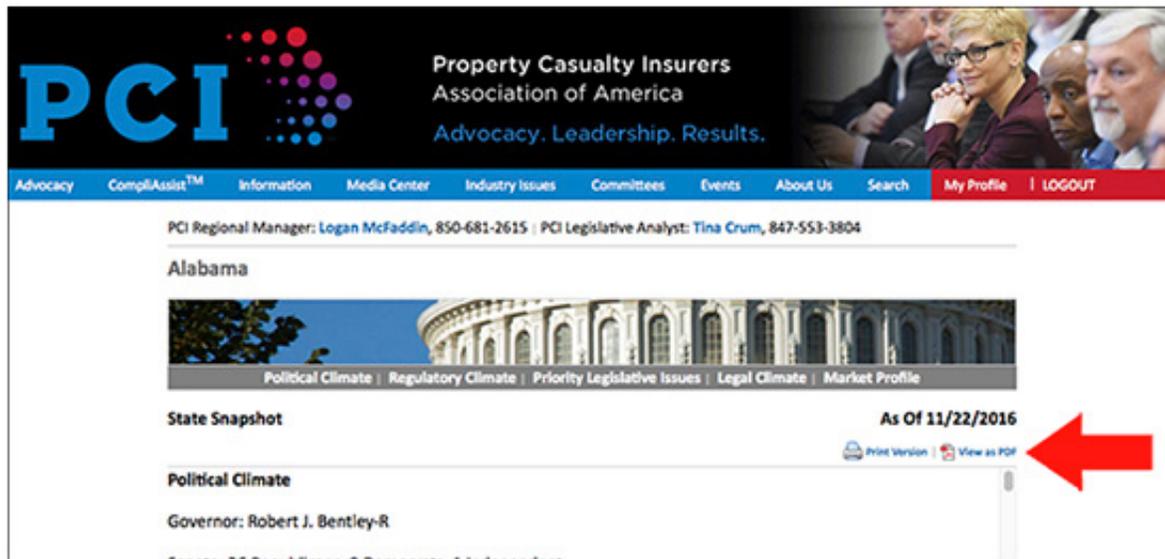
We've added a new section — Market Profile — to the others our members use every day: Political Climate, Regulatory Climate, Priority Legislative Issues and Legal Climate.
