44 percent of fatally injured drivers tested positive for drugs in 2016, up from 28 percent a decade ago. **More than half of these drivers had marijuana, opioids, or a combination of the two in their system.** Source: Governors Highway Safety Association (GHSA)

A NEW POLL FINDS...

Parents understand the hazards of distracted driving, but more communication is needed about the dangers of drug-impaired driving

42%

of California drivers who have driven under the influence of marijuana admit to doing so immediately after using the drug

10%

of those polled said they are likely to drive while under the influence of marijuana now that recreational use is legal
