A regional symposium on November 20, 2019 in Philadelphia PA addressing issues presented by the recently finalized ALI Restatement of the Law, Liability Insurance.

The event will be held live in Philadelphia from 1 pm to 3 pm, with a Q&A session and reception immediately following for all attendees. You must register but there is no charge to attend. We will also run simultaneously a webinar that will broadcast the PowerPoint presentation.

This is the first of a series of regional programs that identify the Restatement's differences from applicable law in targeted jurisdictions. 1. Reservation of Rights

There will also be a short discussion of legislative issues by outside counsel and members of trades' respective staffs. Three of the targeted jurisdictions in this regional event -- Ohio, Michigan and Kentucky -- have seen legislative responses to the Restatement.

APCIA and NAMIC will provide attendees with a comprehensive overview of the Restatement, specifically noting areas of concern for liability insurers.
